

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Alachua County Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing Tuesday, March 25, 2008, 5:00 p.m. at the County Administration Building, Room 209, 12 S.E. 1st Street, Gainesville, Florida to consider the following items:

Re-Plat for Kenwood Subdivision Unit 3, Lots 31 and 32 (reconfigure 2 lots to create 1 lot) located in Section 17-T10-R19 on Tax Parcel Number 06849-003-031 at 8212 SW 39th Place for Philip Pistorino as agent, RE-1, Residential Low Density.

Plat for Stonecrest Single Family Subdivision (containing 40 lots on 22.38 acres) located in Section 12-T10-R18 on Tax Parcel Numbers 04423-003-000 and 04423-003-001 in the "11600 Block of SW 8th Avenue for Brown & Cullen, Inc. as agents, RE-1, Low Density Residential.
