

RESOLUTION 10-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A SURPLUS VEHICLE FOR \$1,500 TO FLORIDA CERTIFIED ORGANIC GROWERS & CONSUMERS, INC.; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Alachua County, a Charter County pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1 (g), of the Florida Constitution, has all powers of local self-government not inconsistent with general law or with special law approved by vote of the electors; and,

WHEREAS, Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, authorizes counties to lease or convey surplus property to the United States government, the state or any agency, political subdivision, or municipality thereof, or to certain not for profit organizations, subject to specified criteria; and,

WHEREAS, Florida Certified Organic Growers & Consumers, Inc. (FOG) is a Florida not for profit corporation that was organized for the purposes of promoting community interest and welfare, and particularly for educating growers, consumers, educators, media and general public about organic and sustainable agriculture; and,

WHEREAS, by email dated January 28, 2010, FOG requested that Alachua County declare as surplus and sell to FOG a 2004 Ford F250 PickUp, property # RD737, VIN# IFTNX20L94ED03214, as required to support FOG's Education & Outreach program; and,

WHEREAS, the Alachua County Fleet Management Division and Board of County Commissioners have determined that said property, that formerly was used for public or community interest and welfare, is no longer needed for County purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners agrees to sell said property for \$1,500; and,

WHEREAS, Section 274.07, Florida Statutes, requires that the disposal of tangible personal property be recorded in the Minutes of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that this conveyance complies with Chapters 125 and 274, Florida Statutes, and the Alachua County Purchasing Division Operating Policies and Procedures, Revised May 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The Board hereby authorizes and approves the sale of the surplus vehicle identified above to Florida Certified Organic Growers & Consumers, Inc. for \$1,500.00 for purposes of its Education & Outreach program.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
