A Proclamation

Declaring "American Airlines Day" in Alachua County, Florida

Whereas, American Eagle operates over 1,500 daily flights to nearly 160 cities throughout the United States, Canada, the Bahamas, Mexico and the Caribbean on behalf of American Airlines. American, American Eagle and the AmericanConnection[®] airlines serve 250 cities in 40 countries with, on average, more than 3,400 daily flights; and

Whereas, with the introduction of two daily flights to Miami beginning on Oct. 1, American Eagle will link the community of Gainesville and citizens of Alachua County to the American Airlines global network; and
