Re: Dismissal of Petitions for Administrative Hearing on The Rock Church Revised Final Development Plan for Child Care Center Modular Building, Parking Lot Lighting, Storage Buildings and Overflow Parking

Dear Sirs:

I have read the electronic mail exchanges whereby you have taken the position that the Petitioners are not required to pay any portion of the cost of the administrative hearing to challenge the above-described revised final development plan. Consistent with past interpretation and practice, Section 402.176, Alachua County Unified Land Development Code, taken in context of an appeal by a third party to challenge a decision of the Development Review Committee, requires a petitioner to equally share the cost of the hearing with the County.

Please submit \$500 (1/2 the amount from the Schedule of Fees, based on an estimated one-day hearing) on behalf of the Petitioners to the Alachua County Growth Management Department, made payable to "Alachua County Board of County Commissioners." **If the payment is not received within ten (10) days from receipt of this letter, the petitions and administrative appeal will be dismissed.** Should the hearing take more than one day, the Petitioners will be required to pay for their share of the costs of the additional hearing time. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
