A Proclamation

Declaring July 12 – 18, 2015 as “Pretrial, Probation and Parole Supervision Week” in Alachua County, Florida

- Whereas,** Alachua County values community based corrections as an essential part of the justice system; and
- Whereas,** Pretrial and Probation community corrections professionals are public servants who uphold the law with dignity, while recognizing the right of the public to be safe-guarded from criminal activity; and
- Whereas,** Alachua County Pretrial and Probation professionals are responsible for supervising adult pretrial defendants and probationers in the community; and
- Whereas,** Pretrial and Probation professionals are trained to provide the most appropriate supervision services and referrals for appropriate health and human services to Alachua County citizens under community based supervision; and
- Whereas,** professionals in community based corrections work in partnership with the judiciary, treatment agencies and other criminal justice entities; and
- Whereas,** Alachua County Pretrial and Probation professionals promote prevention, intervention and advocacy; and
- Whereas,** in collaboration with our community partners, Alachua County Pretrial and Probation professionals provide services, support, and protection for victims; and
- Whereas,** Alachua County community corrections professionals advocate for public safety and restorative justice; and
- Whereas,** Pretrial and Probation professionals are invested in the use of evidenced based practices for positive change in the population we serve in our communities.

Now, therefore, through the authority vested in me by the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, I do hereby proclaim Jul 12 – 18, 2015 as “Pretrial, Probation and Parole Supervision Week” in Alachua County, Florida.
