Ninety-two years ago, 1923, Rosewood, Florida, a majority black population was violently invaded and wiped off the map. Their homes were burglarized, property destroyed, dreams derailed and their lives forever changed.

The Rosewood mission supports a Mahulda Gussie Brown Carrier Scholarship for students living in Levy and Alachua County school districts in memory of her professional acumen. The concept supports the memory of the 1923 Rosewood massacre, wherein, Carrier was a victim survivor, who went on to become the first and only "Colored" female principal in Levy County until this day, February 27, 2015. Additionally, Carrier is believed to be the second hired African American female principal in the State of Florida.
