The Alachua County Board of County Commissioners met for the Regular Meeting.

**PRESENT:** Chair Ken Cornell, Vice-Chair Lee Pinkoson, Commissioners Mike Byerly and Robert "Hutch" Hutchinson

The meeting was called to order by Chair Cornell at 5:02 P.M.

**Commissioner Pinkoson moved** to erect an interpretive plaque to be placed near the civil war statue outside the County Administration Building commemorating all that died in the civil war and its history. The wording will be composed by a joint committee comprised of the entire or representatives of the Veterans and Historical committee to be approved by the Commission. The motion failed for a lack of a second.

**Commissioner Hutchinson moved:**

(Commissioner Pinkoson requested that the motion be divided for the purposes of voting.)

1. The Alachua County Commission should meet with the Board of the Matheson Historical Museum to discuss under what conditions they would accept the re-location of the statue to the grounds of their museum. **The motion carried 4-1 with Commissioner Pinkoson voting "Nay".**
2. Alachua County should provide a historic plaque near the statue that provides the historical context of its time and purpose. The text should be the result of consultation by the Alachua County Historic Commission with historic scholars. **The motion carried 5-0.**
3. Alachua County should memorialize the history of the 20 or more lynchings in our community. Refer this memorialization to the County Manager and the Alachua County Historical Commission. ~~The commemoration should provide a marker along a public right-of-way near the site, and it should reference a paper guide and an online resource that provides the known details. The text should be the result of consultation by the Alachua County Historic Commission with historic scholars.~~ **The motion carried 5-0.**

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**Added Item: Fairgrounds Rental**

Assistant County Manager Gina Peebles presented the above item.

**Commissioner Chestnut moved** to authorize County staff to use the facility owned by the County at the intersection of N CR 225 and NE 73<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to rent out for primitive tent and RV camping during Gatornationals. The goal is to recover public cost to the County and the parking is provided as a public amenity to first come first serve basis. The County Manager is authorized to use County Staff at the facility. Staff is directed to return with a report on the impact of the use.
