Fiscal Consideration: The Good Food Purchasing Program Phase 1 cost estimate is \$10,000 in FY21, account 001.17.1770.552.82.53. Phase 2 cost estimates will be an additional \$10,000 in FY22, 01.17.1770.552.82.53. Once goals are established, the Board may adjust agreement with the Sheriff to reflect the food procurement costs for the Jail in FY24.

The Food System Mapping project will be designed and built by County Staff. Long term data updates may require resources. The Corner Store Initiative does not have a cost associated with it as of yet. Once analysis is complete, staff will come back to the Board with a defined pilot project with estimated costs. These costs, shared with the City of Gainesville, would be associated with establishing a partnership with a retail operation(s) providing a subsidy for point of sale systems, marketing, or local food procurement.
