Fiscal Consideration: At the previous meeting, the Commissioners determined they would

likely pursue this in-house. For the unincorporated area, this would potentially involve 4 FTE Codes Officers and 1 FTE Licensing clerk/staff assistant at a first year cost including salary, benefits and vehicles and necessary equipment of \$454,000 and an ongoing cost

of \$345,000.
